<b>Reference</b>	Genesis 25:19-34; 27: 28, 32:1-21: 33	
<b>Key Verse</b>	"But Esau ran to meet Jacob and embraced him; he threw his arms around his neck and kissed him. And they wept. (Genesis 33:4)	
	Joseph forgave his brothers who betrayed him	
	Genesis 37-50	
	"You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." (Genesis 50:20)

<b>The Story</b>	Jesus restored Peter who had denied him three times	
<b>Reference</b>	John 13:31-38; 18:15-27; 21:15-19	
<b>Key Verse</b>	Jesus asked (Peter) the third time, "Do you love me? He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you, "Jesus said, "Feed my sheep". (John 21:17)	
	Euodia and Syntyche, two women in the church have strife	
	Philippians 4:2-3	
	"And now I plead with those two women, Euodia and Syntyche. Please, because you belong to the Lord, settle your disagreement." (Phil 4:2 NLT)	
	Paul and Barnabas have strife about John Mark	
	Acts 15:36-41; 2 Timothy 4:11; Colossians 4:10	
	"And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other" (Act 15:39)
